STATICH: May newsletter, week 20

Dear STATICH collaborators,

Trial status

Congratulations to **Vestfold Hospital** for including their first participant into STATICH! As of today, **17 patients** have been included: 6 in the antiplatelet part of the trial (patients with *vascular disease*), and 11 in the anticoagulant part of the trial (patients with *atrial fibrillation*). More centres in Denmark, Sweden and Norway will have initiation visits in the coming weeks. If your centre would like to participate in STATICH, please let us know!

Use of hospital records to identify patients with ICH during the last 6 months

We recommend that you go through the patient list at your hospital to identify patients who have been hospitalised with ICH during the last 6 months. Patients who have had an ICH and who have indication for antithrombotic treatment may be randomised! Patients with *vascular disease* (e.g. previous ischaemic stroke or myocardial infarction) can be included into the antiplatelet part of the trial (antiplatelets vs. no antithrombotic treatment), and patients with *atrial fibrillation* can be included into the anticoagulant part of the trial (anticoagulants vs. no anticoagulants).
