Trial status

35 participants are currently enrolled into STATICH: **17 in STATICH-Antiplatelets** (patients with vascular disease) and **18 in STATICH-Anticoagulants** (patients with atrial fibrillation). We kindly ask you to keep up the good work from the previous weeks and hope to see a recruitment boost before December!

Atrial fibrillation in CAA-related ICH

A recent study published in *J Stroke Cerebrovasc Dis* showed that patients with ICH related to cerebral amyloid angiopathy often had atrial fibrillation (<https://doi.org/10.1016/j.jstrokecerebrovasdis.2019.104342>). These results highlight the increasingly difficult dilemma of anticoagulant treatment after ICH. In the accompanying editorial, A. Shoamanesh and colleagues concluded that patients with CAA-related ICH should be included into RCTs like STATICH, and that this is essential to optimise the care of these patients in the future (<https://doi.org/10.1016/j.jstrokecerebrovasdis.2019.104351>).
